Our cricket team became state champion and participated in the national level Red Bulls cricket tournament at Kolkata.

We have been one of the first institutions to get associated with the Assam Skill Development Mission and initiate the first course on GST for students. Das Commerce College family I would also like to express my gratefulness to the State Government for showering us with an infrastructure development grant and Central Government for subsidizing the 30 KW solar project of the college. Today, we survive on the contributions of clean renewable energy too.

## COMMERCE LAB

A Commerce Lab was inaugurated on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018 in the college premises. The Lab was inaugurated by Prof. Prasantha Atma, Head of the Department of Commerce, Osmania University, Hyderabad in the presence of the Principal and the President of the Governing Body, the faculty members and the students. This laboratory aims to provide a practical view of various financial products like cheques, shares, contracts, bills of exchange, different types of currencies to the students. The laboratory remains open for the students during college hours. This laboratory is perhaps the only working Commerce laboratory in the entire North East.





# NEIGHBOURHOOD MEET



Initiatives have been taken by the institution to engage with and contribute to the neighbourhood through Neighbourhood Meets. Accordingly, the first Neighbourhood Meet was organised on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2019 which was attended by around 30 people from the neighbourhood which included representatives from Marwari Maternity and Research Centre, Lion's Eye Hospital, Gauhati Goshala, Maheshwari Bhawan besides a number of well known residents of the locality.



The meeting was also attended by the Governing Body members and the faculty members of the college. The Principal appraised the participants with the developments of K C Das Commerce College in the last 35 years. The participants expressed satisfaction at the achievements of the college in triggering all round development of the students. However, everyone lamented at the lack of space in the college and an auditorium. The meeting resolved to support the college administration in coming up with an auditorium and additional classrooms.
