






#### VISION

# THE COLLEGE

stablished on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1983, K.C. Das Commerce College was an outcome of the untiring efforts of a group of eminent educationists and free thinkers who felt the need to establish a second commerce college in Guwahati keeping in mind the growing demand of commerce education in the region.

The college was instituted with the financial assistance provided by the present President of the Managing Body, Sri. Ramesh Chandra Chaudhury and it has been named in the cherished memory of his father, late **Keshab Chandra Das**, an educationist of repute, who was Inspector of schools, Assam in the 1930's.

Beginning its humble origin in the evening shift with an enrolment of one hundred and seven students in the premises of Sonaram H.S. & Multipurpose School, Bharalumukh, Guwahati, the college shifted to its permanent campus at Chatribari on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 1994.

The college came under the deficit-grants-in-aid system in the year 1998 and in course of time was provincialised by the Government of Assam in the year 2005. At present, it has ten departments and it imparts learning to more than twenty one hundred students with an efficient and dedicated teaching staff.

Although the college has traversed over a long period of twenty-four years since its inception, its actual growth & development however took place only in the post-deficit period. The college is now in its 24<sup>th</sup> year and will be entering the 25<sup>th</sup> year from 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2007. To mark this momentous occasion of the **Silver Jubilee Year** of the college, a year long programme has been chalked out for the period starting from 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2007 to 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2008 where all students will be expected to participate.

A notable feature in the recent history of the college is that it was assessed by **the National Assessment and Accreditation Council** and was accredited with a  $\mathbf{B} + \mathbf{grade}$ . This has proved to be an incentive to the staff of the college who are committed in their dedicated efforts to strive for quality and excellence.

# ACADEMIC RESOURCES





#### **LIBRARY**

The college library has above ten thousand books including reference books, 12 journals & magazines 09 national and regional dailies and a small digital collection. Automation of library services has been carried out through the installation of SOUL (Software of University Library) developed by INFLIBNET. The library provides OPAC (On Line Public Access Catalogue) for finding cataloguing information from its database.

Barcode technology for faster circulation system has also been introduced. Free Internet & E-mail for intensive On-Line search and Reprographic facilities are available in the library.

The Library Reading room is a spacious one and can accommodate 150 students at a time. The library has a Book Bank to facilitate students coming from a poor economic background.

#### ITAND MANAGEMENT CELL

The IT & Management cell of the college aims at allowing students to fully develop their professional abilities that would foster a strong sense of responsibility. It's core focus is on the all round development of students, with a mission to empower them by imparting market need based training to bridge the gap between industry requirements and traditional education.

The college has arrived at an agreement with a reputed IT enabled Academy (ITeA) named COSYNE ENTERPRISES, which has its origin in the United States. A unique feature of Cosyne is that it facilitates students to procure Microsoft Office Specialist Certification after successful completition of their prescribed courses. These courses are however optional to students on payment. Compulsory Computer Courses are also designed for the students of the college.

A well equipped Conference cum Seminar hall built on modern lines is one of the striking feature of the college infrastructure. Official meetings, seminars and discussions are held in this comfortable and spacious hall.



#### **ELIGIBILITY**

#### For Higher Secondary (Two year) Course

To be eligible for admission into the Higher Secondary 1st year class, a student has to pass the H.S.L.C Examination of SEBA or any other equivalent examination recognized by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC).

#### For B.Com. (Three year) Course

To be eligible for admission into the first year B.Com. course, a student has to pass Pre-University / Pre-Degree / Higher Secondary Examination in Arts / Science / Commerce or any other equivalent examination

#### **PROCEDURE**

- Application for admission into the college should be made in the prescribed application form issued by the college
  office on payment of Rs.100/-.
- ◆ Admission to the H.S. course is held after the announcement of the H.S.L.C. examination result and to the B.Com. course after the H.S. Final examination result.
- The dates of admission to various classes are notified in the local newspaper and in the college notice board.
- Admission to the college is made strictly in order of merit and is governed by the college admission rules.

#### MIGRATION AND ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

Students from Boards or Universities other than SEBA, AHSEC and G.U. shall have to produce a Migration Certificate at the time of admission and also obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the AHSEC and Gauhati University.

For admission to the H.S. course, a student has to pay a fee of Rs. 100/- to AHSEC to obtain the Eligibility Certificate. For admission to the B.Com. course, a student from other Boards within Assam (other than AHSEC) has to pay a fee of Rs. 810/- and a student from other Boards outside Assam has to pay a fee of Rs. 1,110/- to Gauhati University to obtain the same.

#### STUDENTS WELFARE FUND AND FEE CONCESSION

The objective of the **Students Welfare Fund** is to render financial assistance to needy students towards their tuition fees. On application to the Principal, an amount not exceeding the annual tuition fees is granted to the needy students, whose father's / guardian's annual income does not exceed Rs. 3600/- (Rupees three thousand and six thousand only). The college gives financial aid to students affected by natural calamities like earthquake, flood etc. Monetary support is also extended to students participating in various competitions at the State, National or International level.

# Co-curricular and extension activities



- The National Cadet Corps and Assam State Bharat Scouts are national organizations which have helped in instilling in the cadets a spirit of indomitable courage, self-confidence and self-reliance, selfless community service, patriotic fervor, trust in oneself, power of thought and adjustment which are essential to make the youths disciplined and dutiful. Our college NCC unit is attached to the O1 Assam Battalion.
- ◆ To promote 'Gender Sensitive Quality' Education and Environment, a Women's Cell has been in existence in the college since 19th November, 2005. The main objective of the cell is to ensure the welfare of the women population (students and staff) of the college. It intends to uplift the economically and socially disadvantaged girl students of the college for which several shemes have been drawn up. The members often visit orphanages and homes for the homeless mentally ill women and makes donations either in cash or kind.

# Note: A compulsory membership fees of Rs. 10/- is to be paid by the girl students at the time of admission.

Research & Publication activities are encouraged amongst the faculty of the college. Seminar papers and other researchbased articles are published in the annual research journal "Genesis". A bi-annual Campus Bulletin, "K-Cian" is also published by the college. The Literary Forum of the college provides a platform for students with a literary bent of mind to express themselves through the annual journal, "Drasta".





The college has carried out various activities like Free Medical Camps, Mass Literacy Programmes etc. in its adopted village Garooghuli under the Rani Development Block of Kamrup District so far. "An Anti-Cancer Awareness and Screening Programme" by Eastern India Women's Association together with the Health and Hygiene Wing of the college was organized in the village on 4th November, 2006. Other developmental works like providing sanitation and drinking water facilities has been chalked out and which will be implemented in a phased manner.

◆ The college through the Information and Career Guidance Cell (ICGC) enlightens the students on various career options available and also provides personal counseling to them. Personality Development Workshops and Entrepreneurial Awareness Camps are regularly conducted by the ICGC.

#### A few activities undertaken by the ICGC during 2006-07 are

- A Career Awareness Programme on Company Secretaryship was organized on 29th August, 2006 for the B.Com. 3rd year students in association with the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, N.E. Chapter.
- A Career Awareness Programme on Management Courses for the B.Com. final year students was organized on 6th September, 2006 in association with ICFAI Business School, Guwahati. Mr. Abhijit Ghose, an expert from ICFAI, Kolkata delivered his lecture on the growing demand of courses on Management.
- on 23rd September, 2006, a seminar on "Management as a Career" was organized for the B.Com. 3rd year students in association with Career Launcher, Guwahati Centre. Mr. Indranil Pakrashi from IIM, Kolkata also spoke in the seminar.
- on 16th February, 2007 the ICGC arranged a **Campus Interview** for recruitment to **IBM** where seven students of the college were selected.
- ◆ **Blood Donation Camps** are very often organized by the Blood Donation Unit of the college and students are encouraged to donate blood for the welfare of the society.
- ◆ The "K.C. Das Commerce College Magazine" is published annually. It gives an opportunity to the students to express their creativity by contributing articles, poems etc. towards the magazine.
- "The All-Assam Inter-College and Inter-University Music Competition" organized by the college as a part of the Foundation Day celebrations attracts a large number of participants from all over Assam.
- ◆ The "College Foundation Day Lecture" commemorating its date of initiation is a cherished event of the college.




